The Malta Financial Services Authority (“MFSA” or “the Authority”) has become aware of an entity operating under the name of Maxxoin Investment (Europe) Ltd (“Maxxoin”) which has an internet presence at <https://www.maxxoin.com/>. Although this entity purports to operate from an address in Malta, the MFSA believes that this is not the case. The Entity claims that “*Maxxoin is a platform where investors are offered an opportunity to gain up to 108% ROI when they invest with cryptocurrencies while the company mines bitcoin using the sophisticated software. We offer deposits and withdrawals via cryptocurrencies, overcoming the biggest hurdle letting investors instantly transact funds. By using cryptocurrencies instead of fiat, we provide investors instant deposits, lightning fast execution, variety of investment plans and best client support.*”

Maxxoin is falsely claiming to hold a Category 3 Investment Services licence issued by the MFSA. The Entity is using a falsely drawn MFSA licence document:





services transaction unless they have ascertained that the entity with whom the transaction is being made is authorised to provide such services by the MFSA or another reputable financial services regulator. Investors should also be extra cautious when being approached with offers of financial services via unconventional channels such as telephone calls or social media.

Għalkemm din l-entità ssostni li topera minn indirizz f'Malta, l-MFSA temmen li dan mhuwiex il każ. Maxxoin qed jiddikjara b'mod falz li għandu liċenzja tas-Servizzi ta' Investiment tal-Kategorija 3 maħruġa mill-MFSA. L-Entità qed tuża dokument tal-liċenzja maħruġa mill-MFSA mfassal b'mod falz:



L-MFSA tixtieq tinforma lill-pubbliku f'Malta u barra mill-pajjiż, li **Maxxion MHIX** kumpanija rreġistrata hawn Malta u **LANQAS M'HI** liċenzjata jew b'xi mod ieħor awtorizzata mill-MFSA biex tipprovdi servizzi ta' investiment, servizzi VFA jew servizzi finanzjarji oħra li huma meħtieġa li jkunu liċenzjati jew bi kwalunkwe mod ieħor awtorizzati taħt il-liġi Maltija. Barra minn hekk, informazzjoni disponibbli għall-MFSA, tindika li **Maxxion** hi x'aktarx skema ta' natura dubjuża b'riskju kbir ta' telf ta' flus. Għalhekk il-pubbliku m'għandu jidhol fl-ebda ftehim kummerċjali jew tranżazzjonijiet mal-entità msemmija.

L-MFSA tixtieq tfakkar lill-konsumaturi tas-servizzi finanzjarji biex ma jidhlu f'ebda transazzjoni ta' servizzi finanzjarji qabel ma jkunu ċerti li l-entità li magħha qed issir it-transazzjoni hija awtorizzata li tipprovdi dawk is-servizzi mill-MFSA jew minn xi regolatur ieħor tas-servizzi finanzjarji ta' reputazzjoni tajba. Investituri għandhom ukoll jaġixxu b'kawtela massima meta jsirulhom offerti ta' servizzi finanzjarji b'metodi mhux konvenzjonali bħal telefonati jew permezz tal-midja soċjali.
